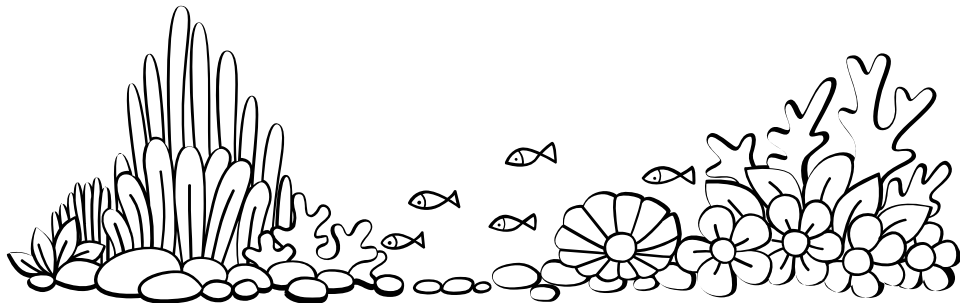


All About Animals of the Coral Reef
