

## Second Grade Summer Work

1. The Learning Program **IXL** will be accessible to students through their class link account. We recommend that Incoming second graders use the Summer Boost skill plan for second grade. Students can practice ELA and math skills under the “Skills Plans tab.”
2. Other skills students should work on throughout the summer:
  - Read daily
  - Practice addition and subtraction math facts up to 20

#### Summer Reading Activities

**Read at least 5 books (on your reading level). Then choose 3 activities below (1 activity per book). Assignments will be due at the end of the 1st week of school.**

**For your summer reading, keep a reading log/journal of the books you have read. Include the title(s), a one-sentence summary of each, and write two or three new words you have learned from your reading.**

**Activities to choose from:**

- **Draw a picture of your favorite page. Explain in a paragraph why this page is your favorite.**

- **Use an index card to summarize the book you have read. On the other side of the index card, write to explain why you would recommend this book to a friend.**
- **Make a picture timeline of all the events in the book and describe each picture in a sentence.**
- **Create a puppet or finger puppet about your favorite character. Write a paragraph describing your favorite character.**
- **Make up another beginning and ending for the story. Include pictures/drawings.**
- **Cut out magazine pictures to make a collage or poster illustrating the main idea of the book. Write a paragraph describing the main idea.**
- **Draw a portrait of the main character and write a one paragraph summary to go with your sketch.**
- **Draw a comic strip of your favorite scene.**
